A Faith Promise allows the Missionary Committee to prayerfully create a budget for 2022 and commit to donating to specific missionaries and organizations monthly. The amount is whatever God is leading you to give. The amount will only be recorded, (if you ask Susan in the office), by way of tithe envelopes, for your tax records.
