- Help cutting snowflakes and prep any crafts.



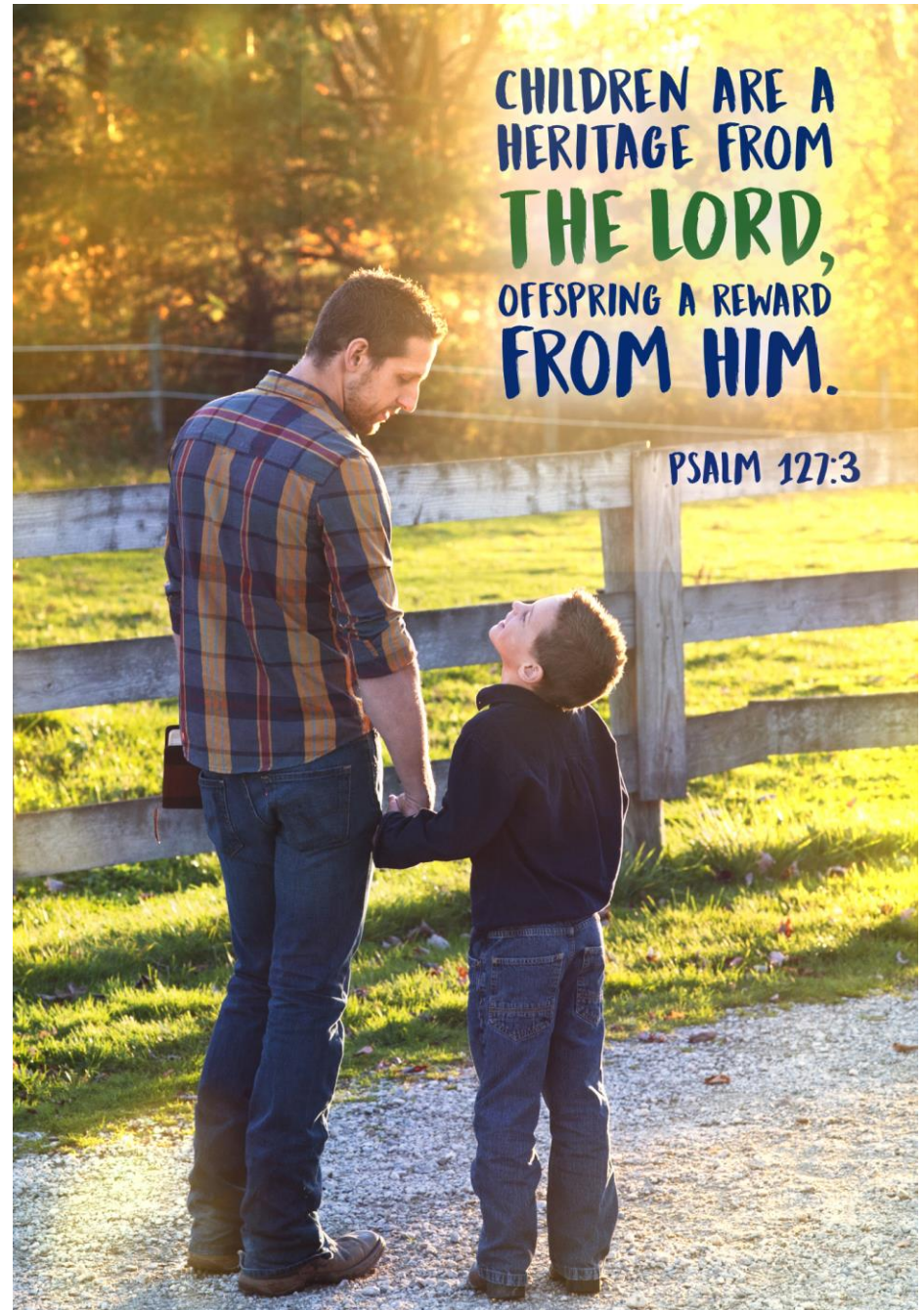

Sophie Jenista

December 22, 1922 - May 27, 2022

Sophie and her husband, Frank, were missionaries with ABWE. China was their first assignment, then the Philippines, leading tent evangelism where hundreds came to know Christ, and over the 27 years the Jenistas served in the Philippines, several hundred churches were established. They also taught and

spent time ministering in Australia and Papa New Guinea.

After Frank passed away in 1984 Sophie continued to share the gospel, encourage, and teach in leadership training groups. In 2000 she went to visit one inmate at the Correctional Institute for Women in Manila. From that visit, a spark ignited, and a ministry began. Sophie and her assistant, Deb worked full time in the CIW. The CIW houses serious offenders. Women in the CIW bear the charges of murder, kidnapping, drug trafficking, robbery, and embezzlement. Others have been wrongly accused, but still face many years in prison.

One acre of property houses 1,500 women. At one time one-third of these women attended Sophie and Deb's Bible study meetings. Because of how they led the studies and the results that were clearly seen in the women (and even the staff!), the officials and guards welcomed them into the prison at any time.

Soon many of the inmates became committed disciples, spreading the gospel throughout the prison.

Sophie would have been 100 in December. And she was still ministering to the women of this Philippine prison well into her 90's. True Memorial has supported Sophie Jenista (and Frank) since 1960.

Jesus entered Jericho and was passing through. A man was there by the name of Zacchaeus; he was a chief tax collector and was wealthy. He wanted to see who Jesus was, but because he was short he could not see over the crowd. So he ran ahead and climbed a sycamore-fig tree to see him, since Jesus was coming that way.

When Jesus reached the spot, he looked up and said to him, "Zacchaeus, come down immediately. I must stay at your house today." So he came down at once and welcomed him gladly.
