

## Tuesday Morning Prayer

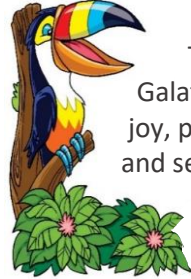

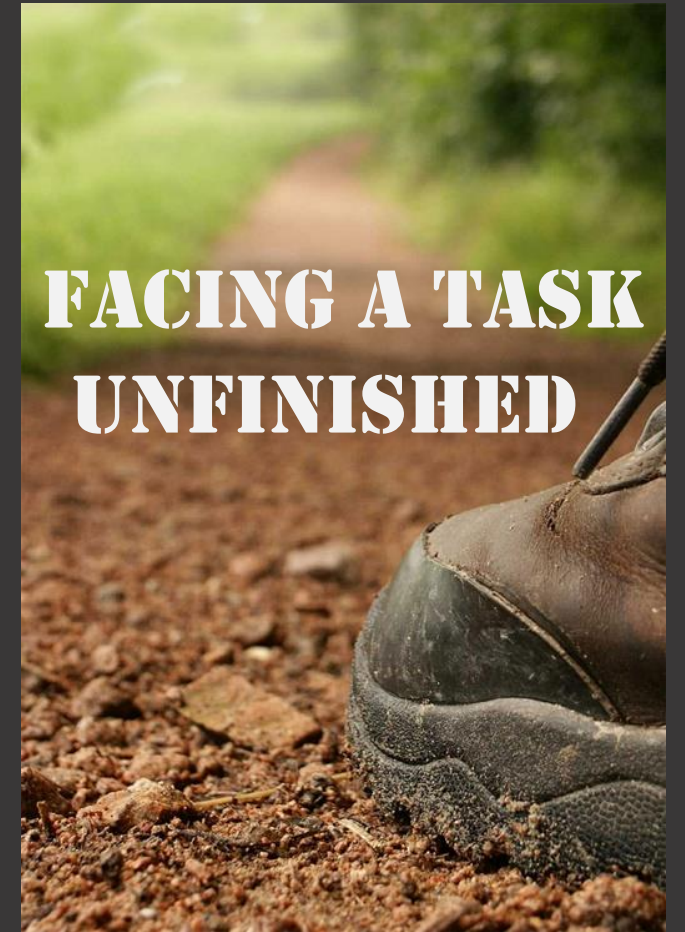

## Spreading the Gospel in the U.S and Overseas

Missionaries that serve throughout the world, are supported by donations. We as a church family commit each year to donating, or pledging, to help support a number of these missionaries. Gifts are also given in times of need, or for projects throughout the year.

Because this group of Missionaries are supported and prayed for, the Gospel has been shared with college students in AZ, Muslim’s in Europe, people coming to this country not knowing the language, to children in summer camps. Christian children’s curriculum has been written, women in crisis with an unexpected pregnancy have received counseling, medical and financial help, the hungry have been fed, Christian radio is available throughout much of New England, people in remote areas now have access to medical and dental care, emergency flights and all have heard about our God’s love for them.

Bibles have been translated and churches are being planted from Peru and Guatemala to Boston, new missionaries are being trained and sent out.

In many cases the missionaries are risking all. Dangerous areas, limited medical resources, political upheaval and in

some cases their lives and freedom are threatened for sharing Christ’s message of forgiveness and love.

True Memorial has two budgets: Current – heat, electricity, maintenance, salaries, insurance, plowing, etc. and then we have Missions- Missions is what is used for supporting Missionaries.

What is a “Faith Promise”? It is people in the church promising a weekly gift, designated to Missions. The Missionary Committee can then prayerfully commit to helping with support of missionaries and missions’ organizations for the year 2023. The amount pledged is whatever God is leading you to give. The amount will only be recorded, if you ask, by way of tithe envelopes for your tax records (ask Susan in the office).

**Pray** – Pray for specific needs for a missionary, see the weekly prayer sheet on the table in the foyer, or request to be put on their e-mail list. Contact information for missionaries are in the back of the church directory, found on the table in the foyer or request one from the office.

Last year we were spread thin with deliveries, not allowing much time to visit. Please help us get the word out about this ministry and the volunteer opportunities. We will need more volunteers this year to host the meal in the building.

Wednesday morning 8- Noon; cut and peel vegetables.

Wednesday afternoon 1-4 p.m.; carve turkeys, slice and wrap breads and pies.

Thursday volunteer opportunities include: delivering meals, serving food in serving lines, wait staff, prepping the delivery meals, clean up or the ever-popular dishwashing. The early times start at 9 a.m. and go in shifts throughout the day. Volunteers are encouraged to sit and enjoy the meal also!

Delivery drivers will be delivering meals to the home bound in Rochester, Dover, Farmington and Somersworth. Usually drivers only have a few stops, so there is time to visit for a few minutes.
