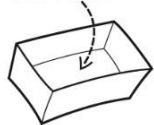

Missionaries that serve throughout the world are supported by donations. We as a church family commit each year to donating to help support a number of these missionaries. Gifts are also given in times of need, or for projects throughout the year.

True Memorial has two budgets: Current – heat, electricity, maintenance, salaries, insurance, plowing, etc. and then we have Missions- Missions is what is used for supporting Missionaries.

What is a "Faith Promise"? It is people in the church promising a weekly gift designated to Missions. The Missionary Committee then prayerfully commits to helping support missionaries and missions' organizations for the year 2023 as a church. The amount pledged is whatever God is leading you to give.
