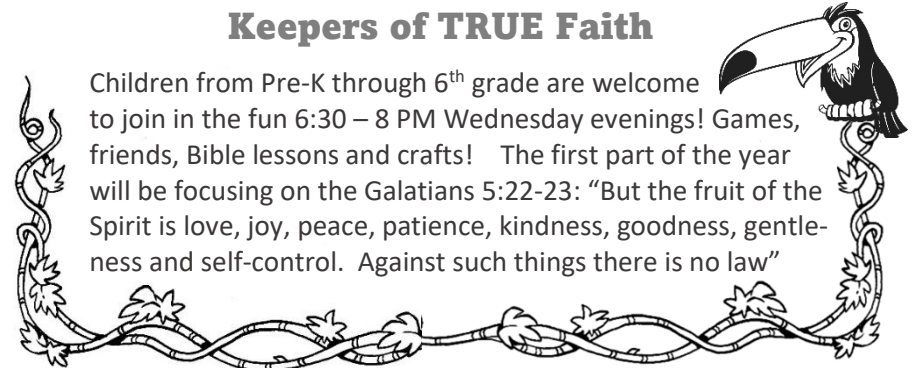
\*Children's Church –AFTER this song, children are dismissed for Children's Church downstairs. Nursery and toddler rooms are open throughout worship.

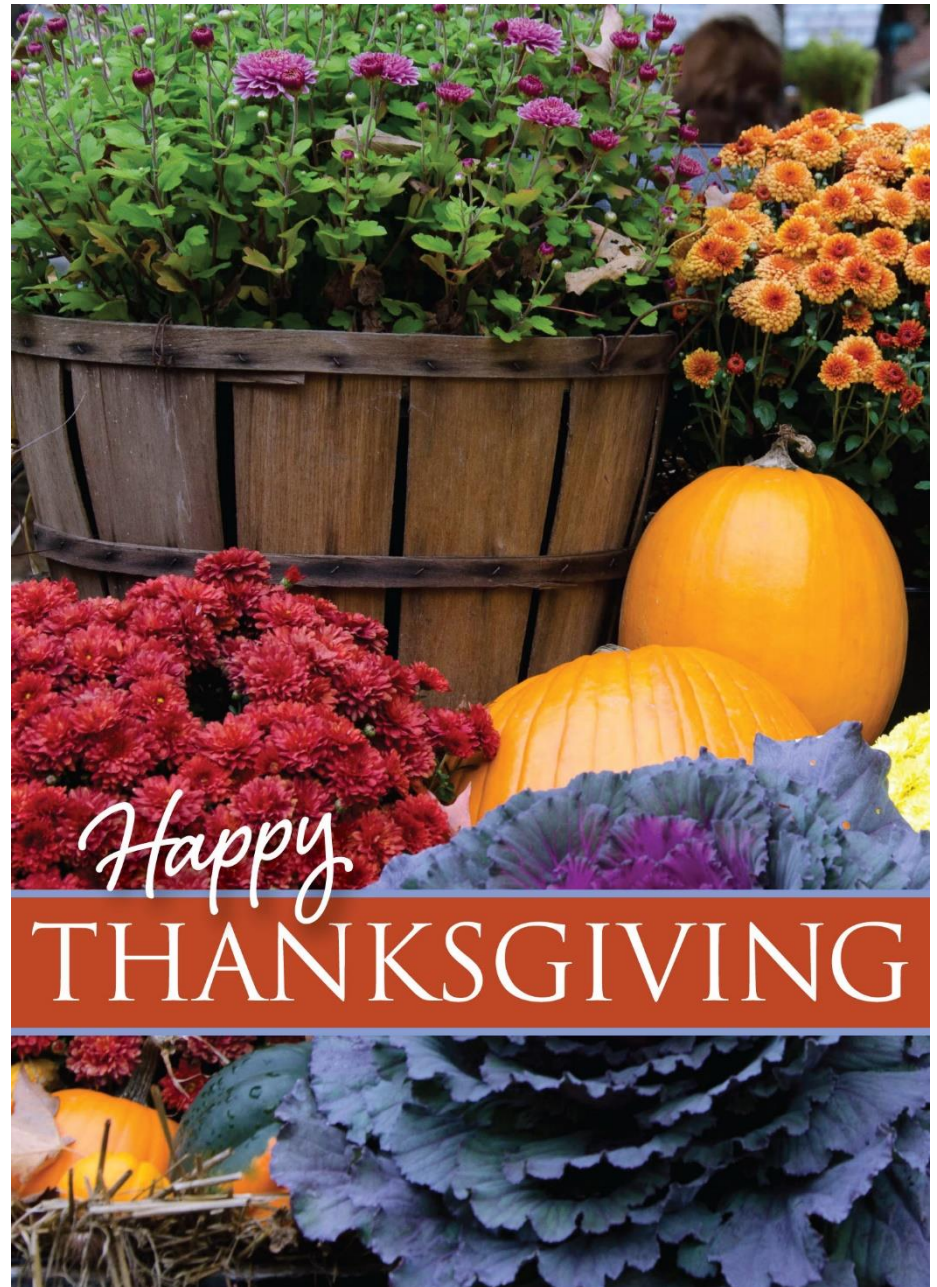
