joy in your presence, with eternal pleasures at your right hand.”*

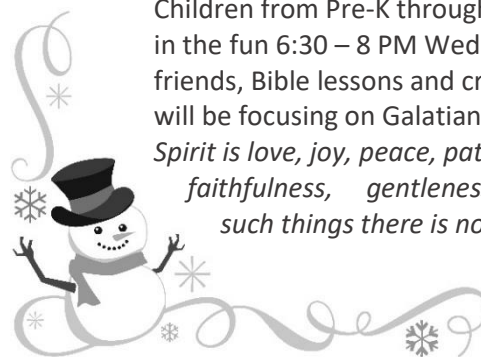
