Emergency cold weather items for Waypoint

Waypoint has a program that helps children 12-22 who have run away or are experiencing homelessness. There was a segment on WMUR about this, and Gail Malone has reached out to the Rochester location for their specific needs: sleeping bags, tents, hand & foot warmers, gloves, (Items may be gently used).

Also needed are canned goods, with pop tops, and snacks. Nutritious items not needing a can opener or cooking. Think granola bars, cereal bars, peanut butter and fruit cups.

Each week all donated items will be brought to Waypoint. February 19th will be the last week we will have a collection box in the foyer. Take the time to pray for each teen that will receive these items.
