Spreading the Gospel in the U.S and Overseas

We as a church family commit each year to donating to the support of missionaries, and missionary organizations. These missionaries and groups work towards reaching people locally, in the US and abroad. Gifts are also given in times of need, or for projects, throughout the year.

We do this through Faith Promises. What is a "Faith Promise"? It is people in the church promising a weekly gift designated to Missions. The Missionary Committee then prayerfully commits to support missionaries and missions' organizations for the year. The amount pledged is whatever God is leading you to give. The amount will only be recorded, if you ask, by way of tithe envelopes for your tax records (ask Susan in the office).
