Thanksgiving Dinner Update

Wednesday morning when the meal preparations started we were short almost 40 pies. As the day progressed the pies kept coming in, from our church family, local churches, a local bakery and volunteers as they came in to work. By 2 p.m. there were all but two pies of what was originally requested! Behind the scenes we can so clearly see God's hand in this ministry!

There were 233 meals scheduled to be delivered to 138 homes, motels and apartments. We delivered to people on hospice and their nurse, a home where widows from their neighborhood gathered, elderly, disabled and those unable to cook a traditional Thanksgiving meal.

Thank you to everyone who cleaned the church, volunteered, baked and donated food. Thank you to the Keepers families for donating the peas and making cards. Thank you to the Youth Group for setting up the Fellowship Hall and the work they did on Tuesday night. Thank you to Gail Littlefield for following God's leading and all the many hours she and her family were here cooking and serving.

Please pray for the families that received the meal. Also pray for the volunteers. We received an email this week from a family that in a time of grief came here to serve and honor God while helping one Thanksgiving, and continued to come back each year. Many facing a loss want to serve others.
