Parents not only learn how to raise a child, but how to create an environment where their child and family can thrive.

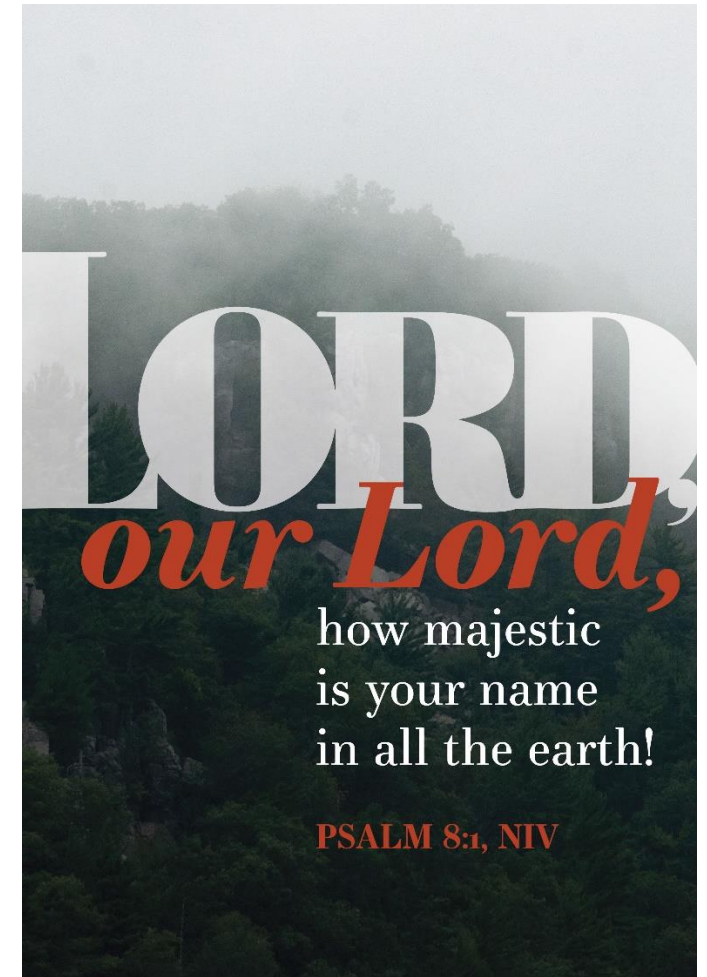
