In March we will be focusing on bars of soap, hair accessories and foldable frisbees.

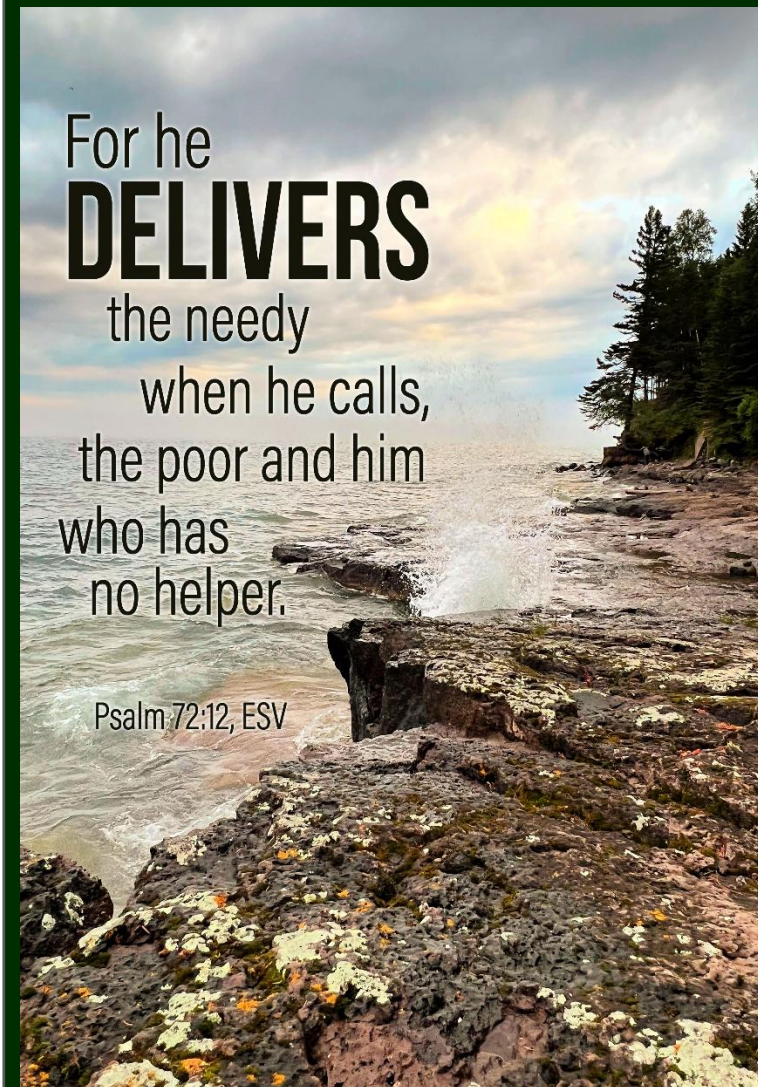
