Dear Friends,

Thank you for your gift to Samaritan's Purse for U.S. Disaster Relief. We are deeply grateful for your partnership and prayers.

We have just deployed equipment and teams to Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, in the wake of flash flooding there that damaged hundreds of homes. We continue to assist people who were devastated by recent flood waters in Texas. In addition to cleaning mud and waterlogged material out of homes so they can be repaired, we are replacing vehicles, appliances, furniture, and meeting other immediate needs. Our teams are also rebuilding and repairing houses and replacing mobile homes for victims of Hurricane Helene in western North Carolina and eastern Tennessee and rebuilding houses destroyed by wildfire on Maui.

Please pray with us that those who have had their lives turned upside down will know the hope that comes only from a relationship with God through His Son, Jesus Christ. *"Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved."* (Acts 4:12).
