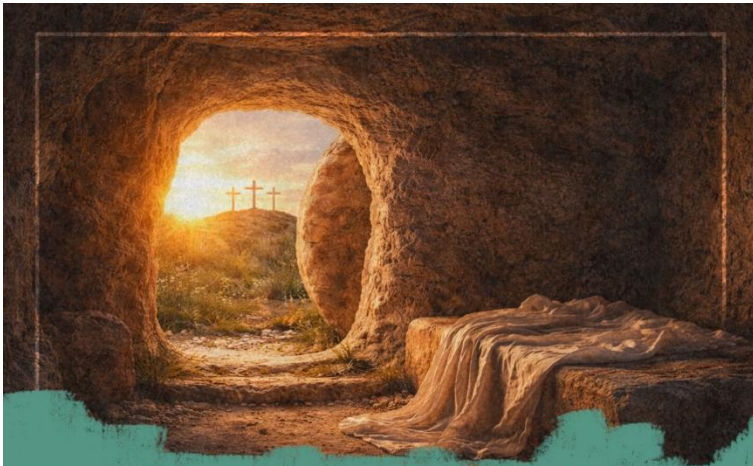
**Leaders Meeting for EVERYONE interested,
